As this term draws to a close I wish you a wonderful two weeks of quality time with your children. We have had a fabulous end to the term with Science Week activities, the Bletchley Vale Cup Interschool Carnival for our students with special needs and our family picnic. Unfortunately I am unable to accept enrolments out of our new boundary due to the enrolment pressure previously mentioned. If you are in the new school boundary you will have the exciting opportunity of working with the new school principal, who will be appointed shortly, to plan the school's future. You will be able to join the steering committee and participate in the decision making of the school name, uniforms and logos. Having been part of the steering committee for Bletchley Park PS I can reassure you that this is a fantastic process to be a part of.

Please remember that enrolments for Kindergarten and Pre-primary close on 21 July. After this time we will let you know if your enrolment has been accepted or declined. We are currently holding enrolments for the new school and declined enrolments will be forwarded to the new school principal. We look forward to working with our new neighbouring school.

This year we have engaged a new photography company for our school photos. We are looking forward to a new journey with MSP photography. Today you will receive photograph shoot keys for online ordering. If you would like family/sibling photos please collect an envelope from the front office.

Next term we will be introducing a new siren time to our day. A siren will sound at 8:15am to let staff and students know that classroom doors are opening. This will help to ensure that students and staff are well prepared for the school day to begin. The official school start time still remains at 8:30am.

Yesterday we hosted the second Bletchley Vale Cup Interschool carnival for students with special needs. The day was a huge success and it was lovely to see students from Bletchley and neighbouring schools get involved. Our school has been acknowledged through the Sunday Times and on the Public Education Facebook page for this wonderful initiative. I would like to thank Mr McNerney and his team of staff for organising and running this event, Coles Southern River, the Ability Centre and Distinctive Trophies for donating goods and their time, Forest Crescent and Piara Waters primary schools for coming along and our fabulous parents for joining us on the day!
