#### FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Term One 2022 has certainly thrown up some challenges, but thanks to the dedication of our staff, unwavering support of our school community and our amazing students, we have come through relatively unscathed and the students have still been involved in some great learning programs. Teachers are using data collected during assessments to plan their teaching and learning programs in an effort to meet all students' needs. We continue to reflect on our practices and make adjustments as required. Our next lot of school assessment will be when our Yr 3 and Yr 5 students participate in NAPLAN from 10<sup>th</sup> May. Our recent Three Way Conference / Parent meetings on a whole ran very smoothly on Wednesday 30th March. We had 557 bookings approx. 70% of students. On top of this, a number of meetings were held outside of this date to accommodate parents. The approximate percentage of parent interviews was 84% across the whole school approx. 3% less than 2021. Given the current climate, we are very pleased with this outcome. We will be looking to run a similar process in 2023. I hope that students will be able to be more involved again next year. We are still considering our options on how we offer longer interviews over a day.

COVID-19 continues to have an impact on the school. To date for the term we have had:

- 1) 166 Students deemed as close contacts (mainly family members)
- 2) 59 Students who have tested positive
- 3) 33 Staff who have been either close contacts or tested positive. Thanks to the Leadership Team and office staff, we have not had to collapse any classes or specialist programs (Languages, Science, Phys ED and Arts) and work packages have been offered/provided to all students affected.

We are adjusting to wearing masks (I do not think anyone really enjoys wearing them!). We continue to apply the guidelines set by the Health and Education Departments and are trying to keep the learning environment as safe and as normal as possible. On another positive note, I am glad we made the early call and moved our Yr 6 Camp to later in the year to avoid the influence of COVID.

On Friday, we will be holding an online ANZAC service (8<sup>th</sup> April). The RSL prefer you to hold the service prior to the 25<sup>th</sup> April and even under the new operating guidelines for schools in term 2, only one year level, socially distanced can attend. The service will follow the same format as previous years. Our Head Boy Jake and Head Girl Noelle will conduct the service. Unfortunately, parents will not be able to attend on Friday, but we will post the power point we are using.
