We understand that there will be exceptions to this, these include: students whose parents are both working; students who are looked after by grandparents; and students who may be unsafe at home. Many of you have already made the decision to keep your children at home, with 80% of students absent today.

Tomorrow staff will be sending out work packages for our students.

A reminder that, during Week 10, we will be providing supervision for the handful of students in attendance with no formal teaching and learning.


IMPORTANT CHANGES – PLEASE NOTE:

From tomorrow, Tuesday 31 March, parents who bring their children to school will be required to drop them off at the school gate or from their car. In Early Childhood, teachers will collect students from parents at the gates outside of (ECE4) each morning and have them waiting there for pick up each afternoon. Students in years one to six can walk to and from their classrooms in the mornings and afternoons to meet parents at the gate.

In addition, in order to comply with Government mandated social distancing requirements, in the morning and afternoon when waiting at the gates, we ask that you stand 1.5 meters apart.

As the Minister for Education has stated, the way we deliver education to students may look very different next term. Our staff have commenced working together on learning content. Next week, staff will be dedicating their time developing tools to deliver teaching and learning from the start of Term 2.
