

CROSS COUNTRY / RUNNERS CLUB

- Top 6 boys and top 6 girls from year 3-6 at our Faction Cross Country event are invited to compete at the interschool event.
- Students who are absent from the Faction Cross Country for any authorised absence will be permitted to challenge for a position on the Interschool team at the discretion of the PE specialists and/or Administration.
- The Interschool Cross Country Team form a Runners Club to commit to before or after school trainings, and may also compete in a State competition.

WINTER / SUMMER CARNIVALS

- All students in Year 6 participate.
- Teams are selected based on ability and sportsmanship.
- Every endeavour will be made to give each player equal opportunities during the games.

ATHLETICS

Jumps and Throws

- Preliminary events carried out during Term 3 PE lessons and Friday Sport, so every student has the opportunity to record at least 3 measurements for each jump and throw event.
- Top 2 students from each faction (plus a reserve) qualify for the Faction Jumps and Throws Carnival.
- 1st and 2nd place getters at the Faction Carnival qualify for the Interschool Team.
- Students who are absent from the Faction Carnival for any authorised absence are permitted to challenge for the Interschool team at the discretion of the PE specialists and/or Administration.
- Reserve is the 3rd place from the carnival, except when 1st or 2nd place has been beaten in a challenge, then 2nd becomes the reserve

200m & 400m

- Each faction qualifies two runners from the preliminary events held during Friday Sport in Term 3.
- 1st and 2nd place getters at the Faction Carnival qualify for the Interschool Team.
- Students who are absent from the Faction Carnival for any authorised absence are permitted to challenge for the Interschool team at the discretion of the PE specialists and/or Administration.
- Reserve is the 3rd place from the carnival, except when 1st or 2nd place has been beaten in a challenge, then 2nd becomes the reserve.



Sprints

- Divisions for sprints determined by Preliminary events during Friday Sport in Term 3. Two students from each faction are placed in each division.
- Top four runners from Division A are included in the Interschool Team.

Team Games

- Any students who wish to be selected are invited to participate in at least two “open” trials which are graded by at least two staff members (one being PE specialist).
- 10 students (girls and boys from Year 3 -6) chosen for each team based on throwing, catching and running ability and sportsmanship.
