FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

It has been a busy end to the term, but in true Bletchley fashion we are finishing strong and celebrating the diversity which is Bletchley. On Monday the students thoroughly enjoyed the Harmony Day incursion which involved gymnastics juggling, humour and crowd participation. Wednesday the school came alive with singing from the school choir, students demonstrating their acquisition of Indonesian, students in traditional dress, followed later in the day by the family picnic.

A big thank you to the school community for the support we received at the Three Way Conferences. Feedback from staff, students and parents has been very positive. We had approximately 85+ % of parents attend from across the school. Parents who attended should now have a clear picture about their child/ren's literacy, numeracy and social development to date. As a school we are getting better at students reflecting on their own progress and taking accountability for their learning journey.


Mrs Bryant's Art Students
