#### FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Students are settling into their new classes and routines, with many strong student – teacher relationships already being formed. Our 797 students are working hard to achieve their full potential and model the school motto of Be, Think, Grow.

The Year four students are starting to get use to having one of the school iPads 1:1 and our Year Five students are further developing their skills with their own devices this year. We would like to really thank the parents of Yr 5 students for supporting the BYOD program. We have had over 95% of students to date bring their own iPad to school. We are still working through a few teething problems but are almost there.

Students across the school are currently sitting assessments in Literacy and Numeracy (PAT, On Entry, SOCS). These assessments not only act as a benchmark for individual student achievement but also provide teachers with a clear picture of what their students can and cannot do. This data then drives the teachers teaching and learning programs.

NAPLAN also occurs this term for our Year Three and Five students. Online assessment will commence from 15<sup>th</sup> March and run for approximately two weeks.

We have a busy term ahead of us, especially our Yr 6 students who have camp in a few weeks. Harmony Week activities are also back on the card after the COVID interruptions in 2022.

#### **Mobile Phone and Smart Watch**

The latest version of this policy is available on the school web site under policies. The following are the two main paragraphs

#### Definition

For the purposes of this policy, 'communication devices' refer to mobile phones, smart watches, smart glasses and other devices connected to or have the potential to connect to a mobile network. *Procedures* 

The use of 'communication devices' for all students will be banned from the time they arrive at school to the conclusion of the school day. This includes before school and at break times. Students are not permitted to have communication devices in their possession during the school day.

#### Parking

Parents are requested to park in the designated car parks along Balfour Street and Bletchley Park Way or to use the Kiss and Drop Zone located at the front and back of the school. Children do not always act predictably so please take extra care around the school to avoid any dangerous or unpleasant incidents. Parking always presents a challenge around schools at the beginning and the end of the school day. Safe traffic flow depends on every parent observing the rules and conventions for safe parking. Students walking or riding to school greatly assists to reduce the traffic congestion. Bletchley Park Primary School is committed to the safe movement of all children and adults around the school. The Ranger periodically patrols all schools around opening and closing time and will issue infringement notices, and fines, when necessary. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding.

#### **Bush Fire Plan**

As BPPS is classed as been in a high fire zone (due to the bushland on Balfour Street) we are required to have a stand-alone Bush Fire Plan. 
