FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

As we enter the second half of term, the school continues to hum along. Staff and students are settled and engaging in some great learning activities. Our 1:1 iPad program is running smoothly with students fully engaged.

This week, I have been providing some system support through engagement in reviewing another school and participating in a principal selection process. It is always great visiting another school to see how they operate and to come away with some new ideas. It also provides affirmation about what a great place BPPS is. Bletchley Park PS will have its school review at the end of term two. We are currently preparing our online response (ESAT) in consultation with staff and will have our site visit on Wednesday 26th June.
