FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

COVID

Busy times at BPPS as COVID raises its head on a more frequent basis. Once again, I would like to thank our whole community for your support and understanding as we work our way through the implications of the pandemic. To date we have had approx. 30 students test positive and approx 59 students deemed close household contacts. We have also had 18 staff impacted. As we become more familiar with the current guidelines there are a few key pieces of information in regards to a school setting:

- 1) If your child tests positive they must self-isolate for 7 days
- 2) If someone in your household tests positive and the child / student has had contact with the infectious person, they are deemed a household close contact and cannot attend school. They must have a PCR or RAT on day one and then either a PCR on day 6 or a RAT day7. If one of these is negative, they can then return to school.
- 3) If your child is in a K Yr 2 (no masks) and a class member tests positive then all students in that class with the positive case need to have a PCR or RAT as soon as possible. If the test is negative and the student is asymptomatic, they can return to school. They just need to isolate outside of school. If positive, they need to self-isolate for 7 days.
- 4) If your child is in a Yr 3- Yr 6 class (so wearing a mask) and a class member tests positive, they are not deemed close contacts and do not need to get tested and can attend school. Parents need to monitor for any symptoms.

In the current climate, it would be fair to make the assumption that your child may come into contact with a positive case. This does not mean they will become a positive case.

Your best course of action is to continue to monitor your child / ren for any symptoms and if in doubt conduct either a RAT or PCR.

Parents can assist in reducing possible positive cases by continuing to wear masks on the school site unless you have an exemption.

Once again thank you for your support and understanding.

Parent-Teacher Interviews 30th March 2022

Dear Parents / Carers,

In 2022 Parent-Teacher phone interviews will be held for Kindy through to Year 6.

School will finish at recess time 10.40am on this day.

Phone interviews will occur:

- Wednesday 30th March 2022
- From 11:00am 6:00pm
- Interviews will be 10 minutes long
- Conversations will focus on literacy, numeracy and student well being
- The classroom teacher will contact you based on the number you provide when you book your interview
- Interpreters will be available to assist families if required
- Students are welcome to listen
- If a longer meeting is required, a further meeting can be organised for another day and time.

Interviews will be of 10-minute duration.

PTO will be open for bookings on Wednesday 16th March at 4.00pm

Using this system, you will be able to book the interview times that suit you best from any internet-connected computer.

Please access the system as follows:

Use Google Chrome, Safari, Microsoft Edge or Mozilla Firefox as search engines.

Click "Obtain PIN/Password" and enter your email address. Your PIN will be emailed to you. The email you
receive will include a link that can be clicked on to log straight into PTO, bypassing the login screen.

If you are having problems with receiving your pin, please contact the office and we will assist you.

Full instructions are provided to you after log in. Please note the following points:

- When you log on, the system displays only your own child/children.
 - You will only see time slots that are available at the time you are using the system. As time slots are booked
 for teachers, those time slots are no longer displayed as available. PTO prevents double-booking of teachers
 or parents/guardians.
- When you have made all the bookings you require, you can download or email a report of your bookings in time order for printing. You can log in and change bookings any time up to 4.00pm Friday 25th March.
- If you see this symbol displayed alongside the class name, it means this teacher recommends that you book an interview.
- Other parents may be making bookings at the same time that you are using the system. It is possible, though
 unlikely, that a time slot is displayed to you as available, but is then booked by another parent shortly
 afterwards. If you then attempt to book this time slot it will not be available and a message will be displayed to
 indicate this.

I am sure the system will be of benefit to students, parents and staff. Any feedback you may wish to provide will be most welcome.
