FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Only two weeks remain of term one, where does the time go? As usual, there is plenty happening at BPPS. NAPLAN is almost over for our Yr 3 and 5 students with the process running very smoothly. This was the first year that Yr 5 students completed the online assessments on their own iPads. We look forward to receiving the results later in the year.

Our wonderful Year Six students and staff returned from their 4-day 3-night camp to Dwellingup safely but exhausted. By all accounts, they had a great time and students were pushed out of their comfort zones on a number of occasions to face their fears. I saw this first hand for myself on the Thursday. It was great for staff and students to see each other in a different environment and build strong relationships. Once again, I need to acknowledge the staff that attended and gave up their own time. There are not too many professions and not too many people who would work an additional 48 hours for no additional pay and take on the responsibility of looking after 109 students social, behavioural, medical, diet and over all wellbeing. Staff really appreciated the positive comments from parents on the closed Facebook site and the understanding that after supervising students 24 / 7 they still find time to post photos to keep parents informed. Once again, I would like to thank the staff for your dedication to the students at BPPS.


