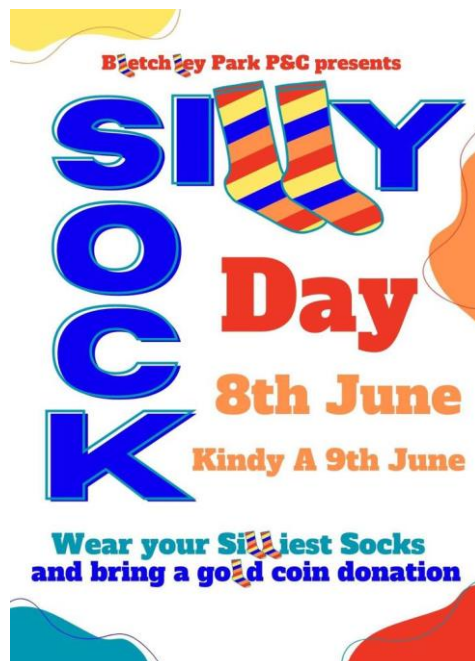
P&C Mother's Day Stall – Thank You for your Support
