School Development Day

Staff worked very hard on the Friday SDD reviewing school data and our presentation for the upcoming school review in Week 11. We unpacked 'The Standard' in all six domains which is what the school's performance will be compared to. We looked at what evidence we have against each standard and rated the school's performance. We will make a few final adjustments before submitting the evidence for review.

Cross Country

This annual event occurs this Friday 7th June for our Yr 3-6 students. The first race commences at approx 8:50am. We look forward to lots of support as our students demonstrate their skills.

Digital Technologies 1:1 Devices

Many parents would be aware that we trialed and then implemented one on one iPad for our Yr 4 – Yr 6 students with Yr 4 students accessing school supplied iPads. We have been well supported by the community with over 98% of our Yr 5 and 6 students having their own device. Anecdotal evidence has indicated students are more engaged and students strategically using technologies to optimise opportunities in learning, work and manage their wellbeing.

We are now considering making Yr 4 – Yr 6 BYOD (parent provided) and supplying our school iPads to Yr 3 1:1 in 2025. This will allow us to expand student exposure to the digital world and provide a better financial balance /life span for BYOD Yr 4 – Yr6 as students will get three years use of their own device compared to two years. We will be providing more information to our Yr 3 and 4 parents shortly. If you have any initial questions, please feel free to contact a member of the leadership team.

Reports

Reports Semester One reports are currently being finalized and will be sent home on Tuesday 25th June (Tuesday of the last week of term). Once again, a reminder that if you have any concerns about the information contained in the report, please make an appointment with the appropriate teacher (including specialists) at a mutually agreeable time. The formal report is only one tool that the school uses to provide feedback on student progress at BPPS. The parent information sessions held at the beginning of Term 1, the Three Way Conference held at the end of Term 1 and the parent open afternoon that will be held in Term 3 are some of the other methods used. Staff also use See Saw and parents can meet with staff on request.

It was great to see so many students and parents at the official opening of the oval playground; thanks to the P&C and the community for your support.

Important message – Children's Crossing

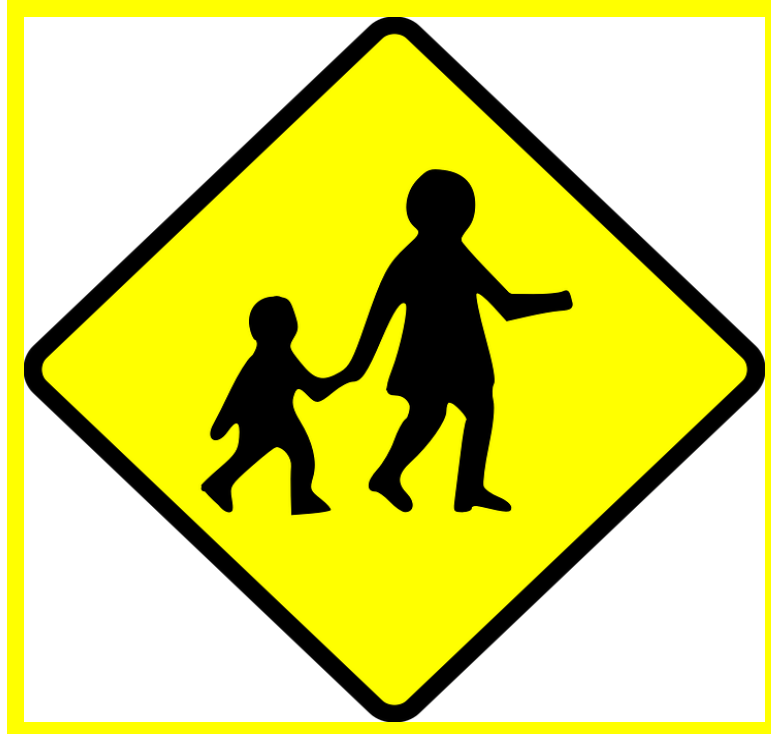
SOUTHERN RIVER: Balfour Street near Tropic Mews Loc # 652
