

Thank you from our 2022 P&C

At Bletchley Park Primary School our P&C committee for 2022 consisted of 11 financial members.

All parents are invited to become involved in P&C activities which support school operations, teachers and students, whilst encouraging a strong sense of community.

This year, the P&C and parent volunteers have been responsible for the running and coordination of the following initiatives:

- Free Dress Days including One Colour Day, Career Dress-Up Day and PJ Day
- Dough-Raiser Doughnut Drive
- Easter Colouring-In Competition
- Mother's Day & Father's Day Stalls
- Second-Hand Book Sale
- Entertainment Books
- Battle of the Decades Quiz Night
- Hawaiian Luau Disco
- Pop-Up Hair Accessory Stall selling hair bows and ties in school & faction colours

These fundraising initiatives together raised \$35,000 and will be allocated for spend early next year.

The P&C also supports the Bletchley Park Billy Goats fathering group, which aims to connect dads and father figures within the community. In 2022, the group held a BBQ Fundraiser with proceeds donated to Beyond Blue, hosted an evening with Paul Litherland of Surf Safe Online, and organised a fun-filled family Nerf battle on the school oval.

The P&C has provided the school with financial assistance in the amount of \$47,210.22 through contributions to a variety of projects, services and equipment. Sometimes these contributions are visible for all to see, such as the Library Refurbishment, but sometimes they're not so visible, such as support for the Chaplaincy Program.

This year the P&C has contributed funds to the following:

- Chaplaincy Program
- Hardship Fund
- ECE Mud Kitchen Rejuvenation
- 6 x Keyboards to enhance the Music Program for all years
- Soccer Goal Installation
- 6 x Water Bottle Fillers fitted to existing drinking fountains across the school grounds
- Library Refurbishment including the installation of new carpet, paintwork, signage, furniture and shelving.

Our success as a P&C is not just measured by the funds we raise, but also in the other ways we contribute. So with this in mind, and the passion to improve connections with families we are excited to launch a new service come 2023. We hope the introduction of a Second-Hand Uniform shop onsite, will provide affordable and sustainable preloved uniforms for BPPS families and help improve the visibility of the P&C within our school community.

Being a volunteer takes a huge amount of time and dedication and I would like to acknowledge everyone who has helped make our committee a success in 2022. We have enjoyed great success thanks only to the sacrifices you have made and the efforts that you have contributed. Special mention to long standing member, Jacqui Watts. Jacqui has been an integral member of the P&C for the past 10 years and we wish to thank her for years of commitment and dedication.

The P&C is only as strong as its members and with membership at an all-time low, I implore everyone to get involved...you might be pleasantly surprised how rewarding the experience can be.




