Thank you to the parents who took the time to complete the National School Opinion Survey last term. We received 201 responses well up on the 96 last time it was conducted.

85% of parents either agree or strongly agree that SeeSaw is an effective communication tool.

85% of parents also agreed or strongly agreed that the school's vision for digital technologies will meet their child's need in the foreseeable future.

91% of parents agree or strongly agree that they are happy to support early close once a year so the school can conduct Three Way Conferences / Parent Meetings.

The following graph indicates the overall responses. Generally speaking, the data indicates that the community is happy with all aspects of Bletchley Park PS. An average score above 4 places us in the, agree to strongly agree, categories.



### Day for Daniel - Friday 28th October




