


Guest Speaker for Year 6 Students - High School Transition

This is one aspect that has been missing and requested by parents from our current ordering system. Another great feature will be the ability to see exactly what you are ordering as most foods will have a photo to show you not only the portion size but what your lunch will look like.

We will continue with our current ordering system until the end of this year so you have plenty of time to use any funds in your QuickClik account.

You may add your new 2023 class number once you start ordering next year. There is no need at this time to load funds, in-fact Spriggy Schools offer a pay as you go system with a 29c per order fee and no other costs to parents.

Kiss and Drive



Parents - Kiss and Drive

- The Kiss and Drive zone is for your child's safety, your convenience, and to minimise congestion and confusion.
- Three minutes is the maximum time allowed for standing in the Kiss and Drive zone during the designated times of 8:00-8:45am and 2:30-3:15pm.
- Driver and passengers must remain in the vehicle.
- Pull into the Kiss and Drive zone as far forward as you can. This allows a continuous flow of traffic along Bletchley Park Way and Balfour Street.
- · Do not leave your vehicle.
- Children should exit vehicle on the kerb side of the car.
- Children should travel with bags in the car (not in boot).
- Be timely. Make sure your children enter or exit the vehicle within two minutes.
- Stay in sequence. Don't cut into the queue. Allow other vehicles to follow you into the Kiss and Drive zone in an orderly manner.
- If you cannot see your child waiting, exit the Kiss and Drive, proceed around the block and re-enter the Kiss and Drive zone.
- Ensure children have safety restraints fastened before driving off.
- Do not do U-Turns in busy school zones. They are dangerous and put all children at risk. It is dangerous and illegal.
- Do not reverse into oncoming traffic.
- · City of Gosnells Parking Rangers patrol regularly.
