REMAINDER OF TERM 2 ARRANGEMENTS UPDATE


Last week the government announced the implementation of Phase 3 of the COVID-19 WA roadmap. This included a number of welcomed changes such as an increase in the number of people at non-work gatherings.

For our school the key issue is that physical distancing is to continue with gatherings not to exceed 100 people at indoor settings and 300 people at outdoor settings. In line with the latest Health advice current Term 2 arrangements have been reviewed with the following to take effect from **Week 7, Monday 8 June 2020**:

- All students are expected to attend school, except for those students medically referred to learn from home.
- The oval gates will be open from 8.00am for early supervision.
- Parents/carers and visitors may come on to the school site to attend pre-arranged meetings. As we cannot meet the recommended standard for pick up and drop off (this should be limited to a maximum of 100 people with physical distancing of one person per 2 square metres) we ask that parents/carers of Year P-6 children continue to drop children at the school gate and do not enter school grounds. I have received positive feedback from parents and staff about the current operations in place for student drop off and pick up, especially with our Early Childhood students where their independence and resilience has shown a positive increase.
- Kindy parents can drop their children off at class but should say their good byes on the veranda. We will maintain the staggered finish at the end of the day for our K, P and 1 students.
- Contact sport and training is now permitted.
- Interscholar sports can occur with a total not exceeding 100 people for indoor settings and not exceeding 300 people in outdoor settings.
- Camps can recommence, however should not exceed 100 people.
- Choir can commence with a total not exceeding 100 people. Physical distancing of one person per 2 square metres should apply.
- Excursions can occur. However, they should not exceed 100 people for indoor settings and not exceed 300 people in outdoor settings.
- Assemblies will remain suspended until further notice as the standard cannot be met.
- School, therapy and public swimming pools are open for up to 100 people in any given space ensuring physical distancing and good hygiene practices.
- The extra cleaning and hygiene practices implemented at the start of Term 2 will continue.

We thank you for your continued support as we move forward in meeting the prescribed health operating guidelines for our school. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact our reception.
